This journal is abstracted in *Scopus* and *Web of Science core collection*. The papers should be of 10 pages average, maximum 15 pages, and should be written in standard LaTeX, in good English (please, get help if you are not native speaker). The submission deadline is August 5, 2019.

Finally, a **2-days pre-conference symposium** is planned in the beginning of August. The aim of the event is to prepare postgraduates students & early carrier researchers and get them familiar with materials related to the conference topics.
