Based on the conference proceedings, a collection of papers will be published and subsequently indexed in the RSCI.

Paper submission

Registration and paper submission are open from April 26, 2021 through June 1, 2021. Papers should be submitted electronically via the Lomonosov Scientific and Educational Portal on the Conference website <https://lomonosov-msu.ru/rus/event/6786/> (strictly through the electronic registration system). The Conference program will be available on the site after the registration and paper processing period is over.

The authors are to register at the Lomonosov Scientific and Educational Portal at <http://www.lomonosov-msu.ru> (unless already registered). Then they should visit the Conference website at <https://lomonosov-msu.ru/rus/event/6786/>, click the Apply button, fill in the online application form, and upload the paper file.

The same person can be author (co-author) of no more than 2 papers. The critical plagiarism level is 30%. Otherwise, the paper is not considered acceptable for publication. In this case, it may be either recommended for correction or rejected.

Format requirements

The paper should not exceed 5 pages, including up to a total of two tables and one figure, a reference list (up to seven sources published within the past ten years).

The text is submitted electronically in MS Word format **in Russian or English**. All margins are 2 cm. Font: Times New Roman, font size for text –14 pt, for tables – 12 pt ; single line spacing; 1.25 first line indent.

The Universal Decimal Classification (UDC) code is placed on the left without any indent; the paper title – centered, no indent; double space; Surname, First Name, Patronymic; position, institution, e-mail; double space; Abstract (up to five lines); double space; Key words (3-5).

Tables are preceded by the appropriate label (Table 1) on the right, the title of the table is on the next line, centered (no indent). All tables must be cited in the text.

Figures and graphs are included as a JPG image; block diagrams are not allowed. Figure captions (Figure) are placed under the image, centered (no indent).

The list of references must meet GOST 7.1.-2003 requirements. In-text references must be placed in square brackets.

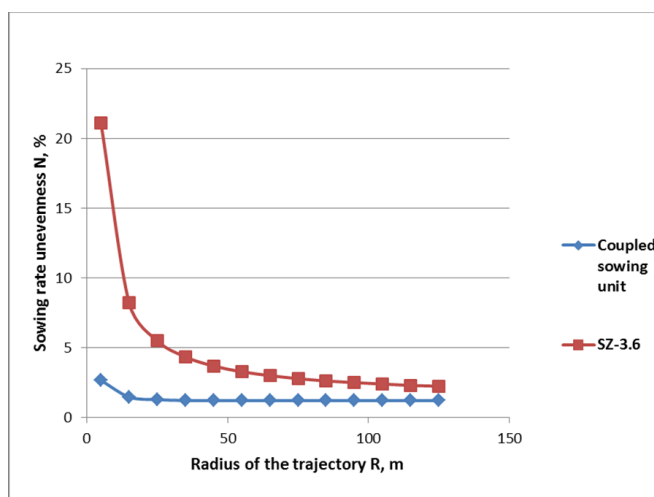


Figure 1 Relationship between seeding rate unevenness N and the trajectory radius R
